

Student Instructions for LLN Robot

Do I have to do it?

If applying for VSL and you do not have a Year 12 certificate or a Certificate IV, then Yes.

When do I need to do it?

Prior to confirming enrolment, it must be done in a single sitting.

- During the Pre-training review
- or
- A link can be emailed to you prior to attending the information and enrolment session

The assessment takes an average of 40 minutes -1.5 hour to complete.

Let us know when you want to complete it, you must complete it by yourself.

Resources you will need

Computer or tablet, speakers, internet, access to your emails, pen, paper to us the link we send you, calculator, paper and pen.

What score do I need to pass?

You must get at least 13/15 to be considered at exit level 3 for both the Numeracy and reading sections.

Results will be sent direct to us – and we will let you know how you fared.

Keep in mind!

The test is difficult, especially if you have been out of school for a long period of time. For example, you may not remember certain numeracy skills, adverbs or pronouns. However, as you are studying a Diploma, you should be able to research the skills and formulae online and put them into practice during the quiz.

Take your time on every question, do not guess and use pen and paper.

Use google, if you don't remember how to complete numeracy tasks or certain language skills.

You cannot seek help with the actual questions. But if you need help using the computer, logging in and using LLN robot, we can provide that assistance.

What if I fail?

You cannot enrol. Review your results with a staff member:

Only a few wrong: We recommend you take the test again, utilise the reading and writing and numeracy help document on our website.

Lots incorrect: We recommend you undertake a lower level course prior to the Diploma to improve your LLN skills, such as Certificate IV level course. You can allow them to take the test again, however we do not recommend it without further training.

You can attempt the test a maximum of **3 times**.

Fail once – you can complete again in your own time, we must resend you a new link.

Fail a 2nd time, you must read the support documents and send an email (info@mcfce.com.au) stating you have completed this and requesting access a third time. The third test must be completed with a MCFE staff member present at the head office.
