This course provides you with the theoretical knowledge and practical skills necessary to control traffic using a stop/slow bat and set up traffic management signs and devices. Our course includes practical training, giving you 'On Road' experience and increasing your employment opportunities.

Areas covered include but are not limited to:

- Site and equipment safety requirements
- Basic signalling, Signs and devices
- Traffic management plans, Traffic control signage and barricades
- Radio operations
- State and territory traffic management legislation
- JSAs/Safe work method statements

Refresher training is also available to those wishing to renew their traffic control card before it expires. To undertake refresher training, you will need your employer to complete a logbook confirming your participation in 3 recent traffic projects.



Entry Requirements

Whilst there are no pre-requisites for entry into this qualification, having basic numeracy, reading, communication and problem solving skills is required.

Location

Our main training is located at 9 Tuscan Court, Thomastown. Venues are hired in other areas so please contact Melbourne College of Further Education (MCFE) to enquire where your nearest course is.

Fees and Charges

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Delivery and Assessment

Our course is delivered via face to face training. Assessment of this short course is via written and oral questions, as well as observation of practical skills. To complete this qualification you will be required to participate in three (3) live traffic projects, one involving construction vehicles.

If you are undertaking refresher training, you are required to attend the theory portion and provide your current traffic control along with a logbook completed by your employer of 3 recent jobs you have completed. An MCFE trainer will assess your competency, generally in a workplace or simulated classroom environment. Assessments may be adjusted to meet individual needs within the course rules.
